



PRIVACY POLICY

In accordance with art. 13 of the Privacy Code (Italian Legislative Decree number 196/2003, pursuant to Law number 196 dated 30 June 2003, n. 196 of the Consolidated Law of the rules on the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal data)

This page presents a description of the procedures according to which the www.enoi.eu website is managed with regard to processing the personal data of customers who consult it.

This informative note on privacy is provided in accordance with [art. 13 of the Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 \(Italian Personal Data Protection Code\)](#) to all users who interact with the web services provided by ENOI S.p.A. through the URL www.enoi.eu.

This informative note is not to be considered valid for any other websites that can be consulted through links present on the websites within the domain of ENOI S.p.A., which is not to be held in any way responsible for third-party websites.

Therefore, when visitors leave ENOI's website, we recommend they carefully read the legal information regarding every site that gathers personal data.

In the following is provided information regarding the processed data, the ways in which ENOI handles such data, and how the users involved can exercise their rights under the law.

DATA PROCESSING AND THE "DATA CONTROLLER"

After this site has been consulted, we may process the personal data furnished by users – on request forms, in the "Contacts" section, or in emails sent to the addresses specified on this site – regarding themselves, as they have been identified or are identifiable.

The entity in charge of data processing (the "Data Controller") is **ENOI S.p.A.**, whose registered office is at Piazza Eleonora Duse, 2 – 20122 Milano.

The processing of personal data shall mean any operation or set of operations, carried out with or without the help of electronic or automated means, concerning the collection, recording, organization, keeping, interrogation, elaboration, modification, selection, retrieval, comparison, utilization, interconnection, blocking, communication, dissemination, erasure and destruction of data, whether the latter are of public or private nature.

TYPES OF PROCESSED DATA

Regarding access to the website, a distinction can be made between the data derived solely from user navigation and the data voluntarily supplied by the user for specific purposes.

Data derived from user navigation

In the course of normal operation, the information systems and software procedures required for the functioning of the site acquire certain data, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of web communication protocols. Although this information is not collected with the purpose of identifying data subjects, due to its very nature it could lead to user identification through processing and association with data held by third parties. These activities of data processing and association are never performed by the Data Controller. This data category includes the IP addresses and the domain names of computers used by those visiting the Site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in reply, the numeric code indicating the status of the reply provided by the server (successful, error etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's IT environment

These data are used solely for anonymous statistical purposes connected with the use and the correct functioning of the site. The data may be used and stored in the case of suspected computer crime to the damage of the site, for which the Data Controller reserves the right to resort to the authorities responsible for ascertainment of any liability.

Data voluntarily supplied by the user

The personal data voluntarily supplied by users interacting with the site for the provision of specific services (information services regarding invoicing, requests for commercial information, submission of a curriculum vitae or of e-mail messages etc.) is used solely for the purpose of performing the requested service and will be communicated to third parties only when this is strictly necessary for the provision of the service in question.

For the purposes of this privacy policy, "Personal data" means all the information through which the data subject can be personally identified, including but not restricted to: name, surname, address, land line or mobile phone numbers, e-mail address, etc.

Except for what is specified above regarding web navigation data, the users' provision of their personal data is optional and users shall be free to furnish the personal information indicated on request forms or, in any case, specified in the "Contacts" section for requesting us to send them informative material or otherwise communicate with them. In such cases, failure to provide such data could hinder or prevent them to obtain what they have requested.

Purpose of the processing for which consent is granted where requested (Section 23 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/03)

For all users:

Personal data relating to users of the site may be used in order to obtain anonymous statistics on site usage, to check the proper functioning of the website and to ascertain any responsibility in case of crimes committed against the site, the Data Controller or third parties.

With regard to users who register on the site or otherwise voluntarily supply their personal data, providing their personal consent:

As well as for the purposes described above, the data will be processed in order to:

1. make accessing and browsing the website possible;
2. provide the users with the services offered by enoi.eu ;
3. monitoring the progress in the relationships with the customers;
4. for marketing purposes and send advertising material.

Processing and keeping methods

Personal information shall be processed by automated instruments for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected.

Specific security procedures shall be observed to prevent the loss of the information, illegal or improper uses of it, and unauthorized access to it.

Section 7. Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights

1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him/her exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed:
3. a) of the source of the personal data;
4. b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
5. c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;

6. d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2);
7. e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.
8. A data subject shall have the right to obtain:
9. a) updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
10. b) erasure, anonymisation or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
11. c) certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.
12. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,
13. a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
14. b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.
